- 1. Dancers will retain the same category status over the 3-day event.
- 2. Dancers will compete in reverse order of entry received.
- 3. Where noted, the organizers will determine age groups according to the number of entries.
- 4. Organizer reserves the right to combine, split, or delete classes the day of the competition.
- 5. Judges may not adjudicate any competitor that they have instructed for a period of three months. If a competitor has entered a competition with a judge with whom they have attended a class or workshop within the last three months, the dancer must step down from the competition.
- 6. Any complaint made by an individual against the organizer or adjudication of an event must be made in writing giving the complainant's full name and address and lodged with

the Organizer, if possible, on the day of the event and certainly not later than 48 hours after the event. Such complaints must be accompanied by a fee of \$25. The deposit shall be returned should the complaint be upheld.

7. PARKING OPTIONS - 2024 - Please choose only one option per "dancer/family".

A Parking Pass will be issued for Option 1. One pass per family. There is a limited number available for all day parking - first requested - first issued.

Option 1. Traditional "parking" on the mountain with a pass. All day parking (nose to trunk). May be blocked in all day.

Highland Dance Competitor and Family – ONLY- shuttle will be noted on your email receipt after completion of registration.

Option 2. Competitors only lot (Sugar Mountain location, Road #2); with AC Shuttle Bus service (not big yellow school bus) for all days available. In and out will be available and multiple shuttles will be running back and forth from lot limited to Highland Dancers and their family only. Drop off inside Gate #2. More detailed schedule to be provided after dance entries close.

Choreography Rules

- **1.** Solo choreographies will be divided in Beginner/Novice and Intermediate/Premier groups.
- 2. Solo choreography will be divided into age groups based upon entries received.
- 3. Solo choreography is a maximum of 2 minutes including entrances and exits.
- 4. Duet (2 dancers) choreography may be a combination of any BEG/NOV/INT/Premier.
- 5. Music for choreography events will be timed. Judges will be notified of overage. Penalty is disqualification.
- **6.** Individuals may use props during their performance; either static or non-static provided they do not require set-up or takedown. Live animals are not permitted.
- 7. The Celtic music must be e-mailed to <u>highlanddance@gmhg.org</u> by June 30th in the .mp3 format. Backups are recommended.
- 8. Per RSOBHD rules, music may include vocal or percussion selections, but in all cases must be predominantly Scottish or Celtic in style.

Awards

The Pat & Steve Johnston Spirit of the Dance Award is a perpetual trophy to be given by the GMHG. The winner is to be chosen by the judges. The recipient should be the dancer who best embodies the spirit and joy of highland dancing. This dancer should also captivate the audience and fill them with the joy of dance.
